Silenus Winery has been growing grapes for fifty years in what is now known as the Napa Valley sub appellation of Oak Knoll District. The Cabernet vineyards were originally planted in 1968, and the winery was built in 1978. For years the fruit went into Robert Mondavi's Reserve Cabernet program as well as a handful of other prestigious cuvees. The Estate sits just below Mt. Veeder on a slight slope in the basin of the Dry Creek watershed, giving it the deepest alluvial fan of the appellation. It is bordered on the north by Dry Creek and to the south by the highly acclaimed Red Hen Vineyard.
